

# Amazing Race Summer Camp 2022

## Standard of Conduct

### **Respect God and Country**

- During devotions, prayer, Bible class, or chapel, maintain an attitude of reverence.
- Students must not use profanity, use indecent language, gamble, or sing music with inappropriate lyrics.
- Students will participate in pledges and patriotic songs.

### **Respect Staff**

- Listen when your leader is talking.
- Be attentive in attitude and action when receiving instruction of any kind from all staff.
- Refrain from actions (verbal and nonverbal) that distract or hinder the ability of others to listen when a staff member is teaching or giving instruction.
- Follow directions promptly and thoroughly.
- Be prepared for the day (see the calendar). Your items go in the red basket and should go home daily.
- Participate enthusiastically in classroom/campus activities.
- Raise your hand if you have questions. You must have permission to leave the classroom.
- Defiant or disrespectful behavior towards staff and others will not be tolerated.
- Note passing between students on campus is not allowed.

### **Respect Others**

- Bullying will not be tolerated.
- Sowing of discord by student and/or Legal Guardian(s) will not be tolerated.
- Display good sportsmanship at all times.
- Bodily Contact (horseplay, fighting, sexual/romantic) is not tolerated.
- Do not take objects that do not belong to you. SCA is at no time responsible for any lost or stolen items. Do not bring items you are not willing to share with others.

### **Respect SCA Values and Campus Facilities**

- A student may be dismissed from camp or asked not to return the following year if he/she is out of harmony with the Statement of Faith or the policies of the school whether on or off property as determined by the sole discretion of the administration. Readmission considerations following dismissal will be determined on a case-by-case basis.
- Adhere to and comply with the camp dress code.
- Vandalism in any form will not be tolerated.
- Unauthorized entrance into SCA buildings is considered trespassing and will be reported to the Nassau County Sheriff's Department.
- Theft of school property will not be tolerated.
- Littering the church/school grounds is disrespectful and harmful to the environment.
- Possessing or using alcohol or any illegal or non-prescribed substance or arriving on campus intoxicated by any of these substances is strictly forbidden.

### **Respect your safety and that of others**

- Walk; do not run inside the buildings.
- Guns and weapons of any kind are not allowed at school (including toys).

## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All Ages: Please put your child's name in all of their clothing and other belongings. SCA is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Please send a backpack every day so your camper will be able to keep up with their belongings.
- Do not bring items to summer camp that you're not comfortable sharing. Toys and all attachments must go home daily.
- 2-4 year olds should bring a small blanket and nap buddy for rest time to stay at school (sent home every Thursday for washing). **2-4 Year olds should have a complete change of clothes in their backpack.**
- **Food Service: Specific info for age groups will be outlined on the menu/calendars**
  - Breakfast: 8:00 - 8:30 am
  - Lunch: 11:15-12:15 pm
  - Food Items are available to purchase for breakfast, lunch, and snack. A price list will be provided. Students will have a money envelope for families who want to send money in advance for the week. 2-4 year old parents, please send money with daily instructions for what your student is buying.
  - All food allergies or medical conditions regarding your child must be communicated to SCA.

## Field Trips & School Bus (Ages 5-10)

- 5-10 year olds: Students must arrive on time on Tuesday/ Thursday, see calendar for bus departure time. **If your student does not arrive on time, care is not available. \*Time we will leave/return is stated on calendars.**
- Seat Belts are required.
- Do not get up from your seat.
- Stay quiet until roll is taken and at railroad crossings.
- 5-10 year olds will receive a dry fit camp shirt that will stay on campus. Our staff will wash the shirts weekly. They will be worn by the students for all off campus activities. Since the material is thin, we recommend wearing a tank top under the camp shirt on field trip days.
- Follow the leader's instructions **AT ALL TIMES**. Students who do not follow the directions given, will not be allowed to attend trips.

## Swimming Pool (Ages 5-10) Hilliard Parks and Recreation

- Follow the lifeguards and camp leader's instructions **AT ALL TIMES**. Students who do not follow the directions given, will not be allowed to attend pool trips.
- No jumping in the pool, running, or horse playing.
- The pool will **only allow USCG approved** life vests. Please label your students approved life jackets if you send one. Puddle Jumpers or other non approved flotation devices are not allowed. The pool does provide acceptable life jackets for students who require them.
- The lifeguards at the pool administer a swimming test to every student on their first visit to determine their skill level and which areas of the pool they may swim in. As students' swimming skills improve, they may request a new test to go to deeper waters. SCA staff assign swimmers to groups and students must stay in the group they are assigned to.

### **Dress Code**

- Wear modest swimwear at the pool and water days.
- Sneakers are preferred, even on water days. Bring flip flops/ water shoes for the pool/ water days.
- Wear a tank top under your field trip t-shirt.
- No inappropriate graphics or words are allowed on clothing.
- Shorts and tanks must be appropriate in length.

### **Electronics (Ages 5-10)**

- Handheld game systems and tablets are allowed **AT YOUR OWN RISK**. Student gaming will be monitored closely and some games may be restricted on the SCA campus. Specific times for gaming will be announced. Students should not get their handhelds out without permission from staff.
- **IPods and phones are not allowed.**
- Surfing the internet is not allowed except in monitored settings on SCA internet accessible devices.
- Please make sure everything is labeled. We are not responsible for missing or stolen equipment.

- **Mondays** - Ewing Park Day (5-10 year olds only)
  - Students may bring their own basketball, kickball, tennis rackets, etc for the park. Items should be labeled with students' names and students should not bring any items that they are not willing to share with their friends.
  - Campers need to wear tennis shoes, shirts with short sleeves and shorts that are no higher than 4 inches from the knee. All graphic designs should be appropriate for school.
  - Sunscreen should be applied before arriving at SCA.
  
- **Tuesdays** – Swimming Days (5 -10 year olds only)
  - Check the calendar for field trip departure times. **NO CARE PROVIDED FOR LATE ARRIVALS.**
  - Bathing suits - One piece for girls and trunks for guys - **please wear it to school under your clothing.**
  - Flip flops or sandals
  - Towel and sunscreen – put the child's name on it. Notify us of sunscreen allergies.
  - Please apply sunscreen before arriving at SCA.
  - Extra clothes and tennis shoes for after the pool.
  - Include a plastic bag to put wet clothes in.
  
- **Thursdays** - Field Trip Days (5 -10 year olds only)
  - Check the calendar for field trip departure times. **NO CARE PROVIDED FOR LATE ARRIVALS.**
  - If you go on an outdoor trip, please apply sunscreen before arriving at SCA.
  - Campers need to wear tennis shoes, shirts with short sleeves and shorts that are no higher than 4 inches from the knee. All graphic designs should be appropriate for school.
  
- **Thursday**- Water Days (2 - 4 year olds)
  - Bathing suits - One piece for girls and trunks for guys - **please wear it to school under your clothing.**
  - Shoes to wear in and around the water. Flip flops *with backs* or crocs *with backs*.
  - Towel – put the child's name on it. Please apply sunscreen *before* arriving. We can not apply sunscreen due to possible allergies.
  - Extra clothes and shoes for after water time.
  - Include a plastic bag to put wet clothes in.
